Module	Aspects of Judaism

Skills and concepts to be developed and assessed (linking to identified AOs)

- To understand key beliefs
- To identify and recognise artefacts related to this religion.
- To recognise features of places of worship
- To use evidence to make decisions regarding individual belief.
- To research opinions and key thoughts from people practising this religion.
- To make judgements by comparing religions.

Factual knowledge to be taught and assessed (including subject specific vocabulary).

- To become familiar with the ten commandments and their importance to Judaism
- Understand the role of a rabbi
- Compare the holy place for Christians and for Jews.
- To know about the celebration of Passover and what happens at this festival.

Formative Assessment/key piece of work prior to end of unit:

- What do Jews believe about God?
Name 4 of the ten commandments
- Why are events in the life of Moses important to Jews?
What is the holy book of Judaism and why is it so sacred?
- Name and describe a celebration shared in the Jewish Community

Summative Assessment:

Pupils will be required to create a pamphlet to share the success that they have had and the targets they need to achieve.



Building Retention: What prior learning must be built upon/revisited and how will it be assessed?

The concept behind this terms study is for pupils to gain an understanding of what is important to people who have beliefs rooted in Judaism. It is important that pupils have an understanding of the history of Judaism and its influence today.
